## Week 4 Feedback:

Although assessing students is generally perceived as an activity taking place at the end of a lesson or instructional process, teachers/facilitators should begin selecting assessment techniques as soon as they identify their instructional goals. Two types of pre-assessment are suggested: one to evaluate the students' prerequisite knowledge and/or skills to begin study of the new subject matter, the other to determine whether pupils have already mastered the subject matter to be presented. This is helpful when considering alternative instructional strategies and alternative assessments.

The main purpose of assessment, as you are no doubt aware, is to determine whether or not the student has accomplished the objectives.
Teachers/facilitators should design means of assessing student performance in the three domains of learning -cognitive, psychomotor, and affective - whenever possible. This may take creativity and certainly time to do, but it can also bring about a variety of learning experiences that require and thrive on the alternative assessment.

## Week 1 Feedback:

We started off this week discussing the importance of evaluation and the importance of both formative and summative assessments. It is important to keep in mind the dfiferences between assessment and evaluation. Assessment is the collection, evaluation, and use of information to help instructors make better instructional decisions. Evaluation is the process of making judgments about the quality of student response/ performance or the teacher's instructional course of action. Note the word "value" in evaluation. When value judgments are applied to assessment results, evaluation occurs. These descriptions will help you determine what you need to do to gather all important information. Keep in mind a couple of things about your discussions: (1) You are required to make a minimum of two substantive responses to each DQ. This means that you need to refer to other references; either web resources or paper (books, periodicals,e tc.) may be used and must be cited using APA format. (2) You are required to participate in the MAIN forum four out of seven academic days. This does not include coordination of team assignments in the learning team forum.
